Hair – Hair past chin length must be tied back for health and safety reasons, for girls and boys. Simple hair accessories must be black or navy. Hairstyles/eyebrows must not have designs shaved into them. Hair dye is not permitted.

Footwear - Students must wear fully white trainers for P.E. and fully black, formal school shoes (polished) for all other lessons. Students may wear black or white socks.

Jewellery - Students may wear a wrist watch, one pair of small stud earrings (no hoop earrings) and a plain necklace (no costume jewellery). Facial piercings are not permitted, including nose and tongue piercings. Necklaces with pendants are not permitted in FS, Year 1 or Year 2 due to health and safety reasons. Jewellery is not permitted during P.E. lessons and must be left at home or stored in the student's school bag/locker. The school cannot be held accountable for lost/misplaced jewellery during P.E. lessons.

Makeup - Excessive make up, brightly-coloured nail polish and acrylic nails are not allowed.

Bags – The Wellington backpack is a requirement for all Nursery, FS and Primary students. Students in Y1-6 must also have a Wellington notebook bag. Students in Secondary may purchase an alternative bag for school, providing this is completely black or navy in colour. No wheelie bags are allowed in school for health and safety reasons.

No hooded jumpers/sweaters are allowed in school.

On special occasions, as directed by the class teacher, students may be invited to dress in celebratory or casual attire. On these occasions, please adhere to local cultural expectations and modesty.




























